Committee made a substantial presentation of a draft conceptual plan for an improved street presence at Playter Blvd. and Danforth Ave., the historic main entry to our neighbourhood. The meeting discussion provided momentum to work further with various city agencies for additional creative ideas. One proposal, a painted mural, was of interest. However siting is an issue so that too will be reviewed. There will be continuing updates on various aspects of the plan at future PARA meetings. Please attend! Your opinion is important.

HELP MAKE OUR NEIGHBOURHOOD EVEN GREATER! STOP OVER-DEVELOPMENT! UPDATE:

The PARA Planning and Development Committee has been closely monitoring some recent appeals to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB) by landowners along Broadview. Here is some background to what has occurred thus far.

The City of Toronto Official Plan designates Broadview as an "Avenue", which anticipates "intensification" and "re-urbanization". Development guidelines for an "Avenue" are based on an "Avenue Study". The Broadview Avenue Planning Study (BAPS) was completed in April, 2016, following eight meetings with our community - four meetings of the Stakeholders Advisory Committee, comprised of residents and business owners, and four Community Meetings.

Upon completion of the BAPs, and based on its guidelines, the City of Toronto then passed Official Plan Amendment ("OPA") No. 343, in June, 2016.

The main part of OPA 343 is Site and Area Specific Policy 509, which generally states that buildings along Broadview should have a height limit of five or six stories, and that the highest story be stepped back, away from the street. It also specifically deals with three properties on Broadview (958, 1015 and 1099), one of which is the Estonian House (958), stating that development of these properties should be "in mid-rise and low-rise form". It is questionable as to what is meant by "mid-rise". Would the 6 storey limit apply?

Three land owners have appealed to the OMB - Estonia House, Gordian Foods, which owns Whistlers, and the Salvation Army. Two of the properties are north of the Playter area. Estonia House is directly across Broadview from the Playter area (between Browning and Fulton). The appeal from Estonia House, requests "...that the site be excluded from the recommended Site and Area Specific Policy 509 and the urban design guidelines ..."

Note: These OPA appeals are not specific development applications for specific building proposals. This is just a first step, which would make the second step (a building proposal) easier.

The fear is that this is the thin edge of the wedge, and that if these developers manage to obtain significant height changes to the OPA, it may not bode well for future development applications further south on Broadview.

The OMB has scheduled a preliminary, logistical "pre-hearing", covering all three appeals, for April 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m.

The PARA Planning and Development Committee has met with our neighbours east of Broadview - Helliwell Place Residents Association and Chester Hill Residents Association, in order to figure out what, if anything, PARA should do, in an effort to help the City of Toronto defend its OPA at the OMB.

The choice is whether PARA should apply to become a "party" or a "participant" at the OMB appeal hearing, or whether PARA simply urge our members, as individuals, to ask to be a "participant". The PARA Planning & Development committee have scheduled 2 more meetings prior to the pre-hearing to decide the best course of action.

A "party" to the OMB hearing would likely be able to be at the "table" if there are settlement discussions, especially if there is a mediation session prior to any formal hearing. A "participant" has the right to make a statement only.

If you can, please attend the pre-hearing as a "participant" and state that you are a member of PARA whom has worked hard to develop a plan that works for the city, development and our neighbours. We are eagerly awaiting the final version of The Playter Forest Inventory 2016. Our next steps in our management plan are to determine what are the ideal native species for our area, how to get them planted and the most suitable locations.
